What Information Will the Paediatric Neuropsychologist Need for my Child's Appointment?

- Please download and complete the NeuropsychEd Case History form.
- The provision of available medical records is crucial so the neuropsychologist has a
 better understanding of all the factors that may affect brain development and
 functioning. Medical information should include child's medical history, including
 information about birth, early development, recurring or chronic medical problems, and
 prescribed medications the child is on.
- Provide the neuropsychologist with copies of previous assessments of the child. If the
 child is receiving special education services, the neuropsychologist will need a copy of
 the child's current Individual Education Plan (IEP) and testing performed by the school as
 a basis for this plan.
- Since the paediatric neuropsychologist will ask you questions about your child's medical history, early development, social history and school history, you need to bring to the appointment any information that will help you answer these questions.

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
